My name is Andrej Kerpan, I am a conformation FCI International judge for FCI group X, lure coursing and 10 breeds group V judge from Slovenia.

The first breed I became involved with was the Irish Wolfhound. At that time, I gave priority to showing and took part in many shows around Europe with very pleasing results. My dogs went to BIS several times. With one of them achieving the World Champion title (Vienna 1996). But I love a good challenge too, so I also trained my wolfhounds for obedience until we got the first obedience certificate ever awarded to a sighthound in the history of Slovenia. After a few years of involvement in training – including at the highest level, with Border collies – I decided to devote myself entirely to my favourite breeds, the sighthounds.

I'm focused on Whippets and with my dogs I take part in show and coursing events on a regular basis with excellent results. For example in 2015 one of my whippets became European Coursing Champion at her very first European championship event, at the age of 20 months.

I have been a member of the Sighthound Club of Slovenia for a very long time. Additionally, I have been a member of its Board for over 20 years and I am currently still on the coursing committee. In this function, I have been one of the promoters of lure coursing from its very start in Slovenia, and have successfully organised many International coursing events in Slovenia and abroad. I am the Slovenian and Serbian Kennel Club's examinator of the new candidates to the function of Lure Coursing judge and Lecturer of Lure Coursing and FCI X. Group.

Last few years I m publishing articles about dogs on the regular bases to the top Slovenian scientific magazin for kids Moj Planet.

During the last years I have been invited to host dedicated seminars for lure coursing enthusiasts in several European and non-European countries, and have officiated as a conformation judge in over 20 different countries.

This is where I met my first Azawakh, and I'm still fully involved in the breed even though I'm not really active on the breeding scene.

My first azawakh came in 1991, my first litter was born in 1995. I bred 13 litters in 15 years in which many coursing and beauty champions were raised. I'm very proud to be the breeder of the first Azawakh ever in UK and in Australia... I'm still sharing my life with 4 Azawakhs.

I was qualified as a judge in 2007 and finalized group 10 in 2017. I'm really pleased to have the honor of judging in your special event in Aarau and I really looking forward!
